## MATERIALS AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

### General

There are no limitations as all our products are made with durability to handle the Nordic weather and aesthetics so stand the test of time. ### Aluminum

Aluminum is a material of high quality that guarantees rust resistance, manageability and allows us to reach the maximum qualitative results.

To keep the product in good condition for a long time we recommend regular cleaning. Use a soft cloth and mild detergent and water to clean your aluminum product.

### **Stainless Steel**

Stainless steel is a durable and reliable material over time, thanks to the high resistance to corrosion and the mechanical characteristics.

To keep the product in good condition for a long time we recommend regular cleaning. Use a soft cloth and mild detergent and water to clean your stainless-steel product.

### Wood

Wood is a durable material and if it's handled with care, it will stay beautiful for years. Being a natural material, color variations or even cracks due to the degree of humidity and sudden changes in temperature may be observed. Never use chemicals to clean your wood product. We recommend that you treat your wood furniture with hard wax oil depending on how much it's exposed. This prevents the appearance of dry cracks in the wood.

### Olefin

Olefin is a textile fiber which has many advantages, for example strength, colorfastness, and comfort. Olefin has high resistance due to stains, abrasion, sunlight and mold. Olefin can simply be cleaned with sponge cloth with soapy water.

Lyre and Solo are examples of products with olefin strings.

### Compact laminate

Compact laminate consists of tightly compressed sheets of paper which makes it extremely durable and very easy to maintain. Compact laminate can be used both indoors and outdoors. Always use a trivet, never place a hot pot or similar directly to the material. Never use any abrasive cleaning products because this can scratch the surface. To wash the surface, you should use water and a mild detergent.

#### Wool

A big advantage of wool is that they do not need to be washed as often as other materials. Washing both takes time and affects the environment. We recommend washing the wool at 30 degrees. Wool should not be hand washed because there is a risk of washing too hot and of twisting the fibers of the wool.

#### Veneer surfaces

The natural pattern of wood gives the veneer sheets a rich, warm and an aesthetically look. Since these are made from a renewable resource, veneers are sustainable. To clean the veneer surface, you should use damp cloth. The trays are not water resistant.
